

LS Quarry acknowledges Aboriginal cultural heritage, including places of physical and spiritual importance, sites, places, objects, stories, oral histories, flora and fauna all of which are of significance to First Nations people because of their connection to country through traditions, Lore, customs beliefs and history.

LS Quarry will endeavour to identify and manage these areas of significance within land either owned, managed or operating on.

On identifying any areas or items of significance LS Quarry will temporarily cease extraction and implement an Aboriginal and Historic Heritage Management Contingency Plan. This plan will include but not be limited to;

- Educating employees and visitors of sites of significance in site specific inductions;
- Rules around avoidance of any sites of significance;
- Implementation of an unexpected find protocols (to include but not limited to);
 - Identification
 - Skeletal remains
 - Artefactual materials
 - Re-commence extraction works

LS Quarry is committed to identifying and protecting Aboriginal objects, sites and spiritual places by meeting our legal obligations in relation to Aboriginal cultural heritage.

This Policy will be reviewed annually for suitability, adequacy and effectiveness and when required by changes in legislation, standards, industry codes or company operations.
