

LS Quarry has a strong culture around diversity and multiculturalism. We currently employ LS Quarry practitioners from a range of nationalities and ethnic backgrounds. We also have a strong culture and practice around equal opportunity and non-discrimination. The next step in our cultural evolution at LS Quarry is to extend this track-record to recognise the contribution to business from the Indigenous community of Victoria and Australia.

LS Quarry is currently devising plans to include the government's Indigenous Procurement Policy within its supply chain and subcontracting policies and practices. These plans have so far identified the following engagement policies

- Supply Chain – Preference is given in the context of strong value-for-money to suppliers that are 50% or more Indigenous owned.
- Subcontractors – Preference is given in the context of strong value-for-money to subcontractors who are 50% or more Indigenous owned. Subcontractors must be Indigenous Enterprises and registered with Supply Nation (supplynation.org.au) or Kinaway (kinaway.com.au)

LS Quarry supports an increase of opportunities for the employment of Indigenous Australians, along with the continued growth of supplier diversity in Australia.
